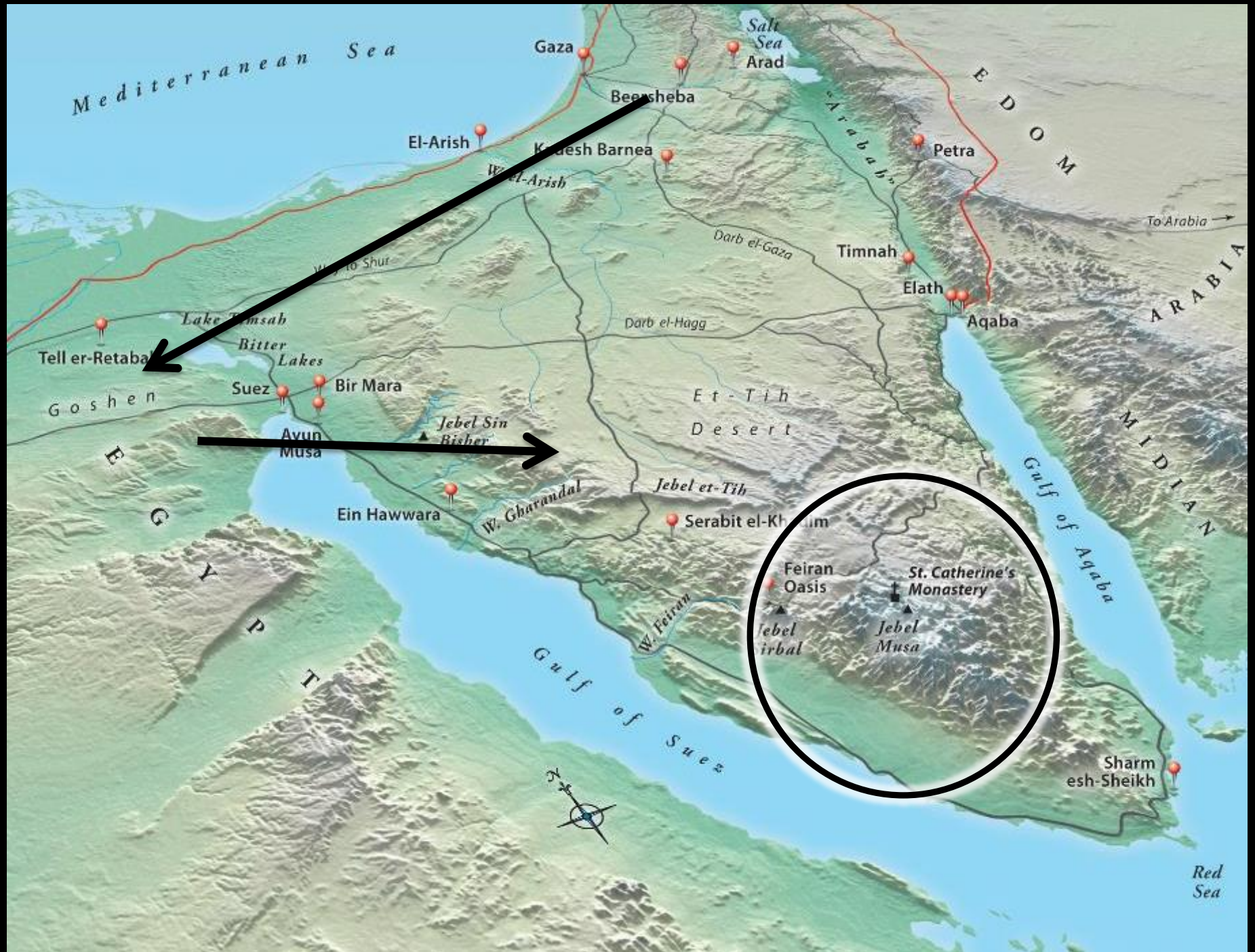
Christ is our Passover Lamb

1. God rescued his people from Egypt.

I have come down to rescue them
from the hand of the Egyptians
and to bring them up out of that land
into a good and spacious land,
a land flowing with milk and honey.

(Exodus 3:8)

1. God rescued his people from Egypt.

The blood will be a sign for you
on the houses where you are,
and when I see the blood,
I will pass over you.

No destructive plague will touch you
when I strike Egypt.

(Exodus 12:13)

2. God wanted them to remember their rescue.

Do not eat it with bread made with yeast, but for seven days eat unleavened bread, the bread of affliction, because you left Egypt in haste—so that all the days of your life you may remember the time of your departure from Egypt.

(Deuteronomy 16:3)



3. Like Israel, God rescues us from sin.

For he has rescued us from
the dominion of darkness and
brought us into the kingdom
of the Son he loves.

(Colossians 1:13)

4. God wants us to remember our rescue.

And when he had given thanks, he broke it and said, “This is my body, which is for you; do this in remembrance of me.” In the same way, after supper he took the cup, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in my blood; do this, whenever you drink it, in remembrance of me.”
