Download the latest Google USB Drivers here.

Download the Android SDK Platform Tools for Windows here.

Installation of Drivers


Put Razer Phone into Download Mode:

Plug in a USB cable to connect your Razer Phone to your computer, Power Off the Phone, then turn it on and immediately hold down Volume Down.


Connect the Razer Phone to your computer via a recommended USB cable.

When connecting your Razer Phone to a computer for any development, it is advised by Razer to not use the in-box USB Type-C to Type-C charging cable for flashing. The supplied cable is specifically engineered for fast power delivery, not for data transfer. Razer recommends you use a USB 3 Type-A to Type-C spec-compliant cable for any device flashing.

Open Device Manager by pressing \boxplus Win + X and select **Device Manager**.




Right-click "Android" device and select **Update Driver Software...**




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Select Browse my computer for driver software.



Select Let me pick from a list of device drivers on my computer. Select Show All Devices, press Next. Have Disk, then point to %PATH.



Select **Android Bootloader Interface**, then press **Next**. Proceed through all warnings and dialogs. Press **Finish**.


Open Command Prompt terminal and point to %PATH\platform-tools.

Test your settings by running the fastboot devices command. If you see your device's serial number, you have successfully completed this process.


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Setting Environment Variables

Open System by pressing \boxplus Win + X and select **System**.



Select Advanced system settings.



Select **Environment Variables...**, click **New** under User variables, point **Variable Value** to %PATH.
