



Please find information on the Children's Organ Transplant Society Bursary application.

The purpose of this bursary is to acknowledge students who have an awareness of, and support, the promotion of organ and tissue donation. By increasing awareness of organ and tissue donation, we can help others make an informed decision about giving the gift of life.

The Children's Organ Transplant Society Bursary will provide one \$500 award to a grade 12 student to be used toward post-secondary education, who meets the eligibility requirements.

**HOW TO APPLY:** Submit the following via email by **July 15, 2016**.

- Applicants name, mailing address, phone number and email
- Name of current school and name of post-secondary institute and program you intend to study.
- One 800-1,000 word essay about organ donation
- One letter of reference (no more than one page)

**SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION PROCESS:**

- The Board of the Children's Organ Transplant Society will evaluate each application and essay. Upon review of all applications, the Board will select the winning applicant.

### **CHILDREN'S ORGAN TRANSPLANT SOCIETY BURSARY RULES**

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:**

- High school student in British Columbia attending a public or private school
- Intend to enroll in an accredited two or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school.

#### **TO APPLY FOR THIS BURSARY**

1. Complete the application available at [www.childrensots.org](http://www.childrensots.org)
2. You may choose to write your essay on one of two topics:
  - a.) A first person account involving organ and tissue transplant or donation.
  - b.) A general essay on organ and tissue transplant or donation.
3. Essay must be between 800 and 1,000 words.

#### **APPLICATION DEADLINE:**
