

CHRYSLER CELEBRATES 20TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE MINIVAN: 2004 CHRYSLER TOWN & COUNTRY REMAINS THE ULTIMATE MINIVAN

Twenty years ago, Chrysler Corporation changed the landscape of highways and driveways by introducing the first minivan. More than 10 million minivan sales later, Chrysler Town & Country remains the premium nameplate in the minivan market segment.

“Chrysler Town & Country Limited is the most luxurious minivan in the marketplace,” said Tom Marinelli, Vice President – Chrysler Marketing. “We continue to dominate the top end of the minivan market segment by offering even more minivan-first features to our customers.”

For 2004, the Chrysler brand offers seven minivan models: one standard-wheelbase model and six extended-wheelbase models. While the Voyager nameplate is discontinued, the Chrysler Town & Country lineup adds a standard-wheelbase model with a V-6 engine. Extended-wheelbase models include Chrysler Town & Country LX, Chrysler Town & Country Touring, Chrysler Town & Country Platinum Series, Chrysler Town & Country Limited, Chrysler Town & Country Touring All-Wheel Drive (AWD), and Chrysler Town & Country Limited AWD.

NEW FEATURES FOR 2004

To celebrate 20 years of minivan leadership, Chrysler will offer a limited edition Chrysler Town & Country Platinum Series, based on the Chrysler Town & Country Touring model. The special model has 16-inch chrome-clad platinum finish wheels, two-tone leather seating, Rear Seat Video® entertainment system, six-disc CD/DVD changer, rear cargo organizer, chrome interior door handles, embroidered platinum floor mats, body-color cladding, and Platinum Series badging as standard equipment.

Following are additional new features to look for on the 2004 Chrysler Town & Country:

Tire Pressure Monitor Warning Lamp: Standard on all long-wheelbase minivans with aluminum wheels. The indicator lamp is located on the instrument panel, and warns owners if the pressure in any tire falls below the recommended level.

Integrated Key/Remote Keyless/Sentry® Key: This new fob design consolidates the Sentry Key engine immobilizer key and the remote keyless function buttons into a single fob for greater convenience when unlocking and locking the vehicle.

Updated audio/entertainment packages: The 2004 Chrysler Town & Country audio system lineup includes three option packages:

AM/FM Six-CD Radio: Includes an AM/FM radio with six-disc CD player integrated directly into the radio.

AM/FM/CD/DVD/Navigation Radio: Includes an AM/FM radio six-disc CD player with a GPS DVD-based navigation system with full color and continuous update map display (standard on Chrysler Town & Country Limited).

Six-disc CD/DVD Changer: Includes an in-dash six-disc CD/DVD changer with integral audio/video jacks for multi-disc capability, a rear-seat video system and navigation radio.
