TO: CHSAA 1A State Basketball Qualifying SchoolsFR: Bethany Brookens, Associate CommissionerRE: Accommodations for Denver Jewish Day

If Denver Jewish Day boys' basketball team qualifies for the state basketball tournament, some accommodations for game times will need to be made because they are a school observing a Saturday Sabbath.

These accommodations are in line with CHSAA Policy on accommodating member schools that observe a Saturday Sabbath (see below for CHSAA policy). The times for sunset Friday to sunset Saturday are listed below for this year's tournament.

Here are the scenarios for this year's 1A regional and or state championship tournament games:

1. If Denver Jewish Day advances to Regionals, the regional must be played on Thursday afternoon and Friday afternoon (instead of Friday/Saturday).

### State Championships

- 1. If Denver Jewish Day loses Thursday and Friday, no accommodations for Saturday will be necessary;
- 2. Should Denver Jewish Day win Thursday, they will need to play their semifinal game in the morning session (1:15 pm) on Friday. This will move one of the boys consolation games to 5:30 pm.
- 3. If Denver Jewish Day loses Thursday but wins on Friday, they will need to play their 5/6 game at 8:30 pm on Saturday.
- 4. Should Denver Jewish Day advance to the 1A boys' state championship game, they will play at 8:30 p.m at UNC.
- 5. Should Denver Jewish Day advance to Saturday's third place or consolation games (5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup>), they will play those at 8:30 pm at UNC. The schedule and times of the games will depend on what game they are in.

## Option 1 – Denver Jewish Day Advances to Championship Saturday

# CHSAA Policy Regarding State Events Due to Observance of the Saturday Sabbath (Jewish/Seventh Day Adventist)

#### Basketball

Should a team that recognizes the Saturday Sabbath be involved in a CHSAA state basketball tournament, and should the team, due to bracketing, play during the time that the Saturday Sabbath is observed, a semifinal game would be moved from Friday evening to Friday afternoon. Any Saturday consolation games would be moved to a later time that evening (even if that means moving the state championship game to an earlier time). If a team that recognizes the Saturday Sabbath be involved in a championship game, that game will be scheduled later in the evening to accommodate the needs of the team.
