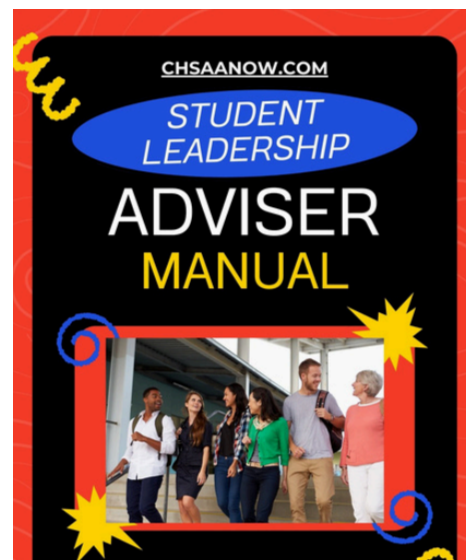
A New Month of Possibilities Begins!
