


# Immigrants in Lexington-Fayette, KY 2010-2014

**Percent of Immigrants with Health Insurance in Lexington-Fayette, KY by Census Tract**




The map on the left represents the percent of immigrants with health insurance. There are areas in Lexington with a high concentration of immigrants without health insurance. The areas south and east of Lexington tend to have more immigrants with health insurance coverage.

The bottom left graph presents the poverty rate of immigrant households in Lexington-Fayette. Lexington-Fayette has 5 percent more families below the poverty rate than that of the United States.

The table below shows the top 10 languages spoken among immigrant households in Lexington-Fayette. With 34 percent, Spanish is the most common language spoken. The other 50 languages are spoken by 66 percent of the immigrant population in the area.

**Poverty rate in Lexington-Fayette, KY among Immigrant households**



## Race and Ethnicity in Lexington-Fayette, KY by Census Tracts



The map on the left shows the most common races and ethnicities for immigrants in Lexington-Fayette, KY. Asian immigrants, in purple, are mostly concentrated south of Lexington. White non-Hispanic, Black and Hispanic immigrants make up much of the areas near Lexington.


The chart at the bottom left displays the percent of immigrant households with or without health insurance. Twenty-nine percent of immigrant households do not have health insurance.

The table below shows the rate of health insurance coverage by race and ethnicity. All Asian Hispanic immigrants have health insurance, while all Native American Hispanic immigrants do not have health insurance. About 57 percent of White Hispanic immigrant do not have health insurance, whereas the other 43 percent do.
