THE ARIZONA LIFE COALITION DELIVERS 'INVESTIGATE PLANNED PARENTHOOD' PETITION TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE

(PHOENIX, AZ) Today, a representative of the Arizona Life Coalition hand-delivered a 70-page petition to the Attorney General's office calling on it to open an investigation of Planned Parenthood reporting practices.

As has been widely reported, eighteen year-old Tyler Kost was indicted by the Pinal County Attorney on 27 counts of sexual assault and abuse. One of the young girls he raped in late 2013 was taken to the Tempe Planned Parenthood by her mother to obtain an abortion last January.

Police reports indicate that the Planned Parenthood Tempe clinic intentionally miscoded a rape of a minor child as consensual sex, because telling the authorities wasn't worth the "hassle."

By law, Planned Parenthood is required to report this assault to authorities within 24 hours. According to police reports Planned Parenthood has overtly broken Arizona law with the most devastating of consequences.

In the petition, the concerned citizens collectively call on the Attorney General to open for investigation every case made known to the Tempe clinic of sex with a minor to ensure no other girls were raped, and no other predators are in our schools and community.

This cannot wait. Not one more child should be assaulted because Planned Parenthood believes their safety "isn't worth the hassle."
