

Discipline

Discipline is the process of teaching acceptable behavior and self control. We use two simple methods that have been proven to be effective and are suggested by Awana.

- 5 count - Used when clubbers are disrupting the group. The leader holds up his/her hand and slowly counts to five. The clubbers are asked to hold up their hands and count along silently.
- 3 count - Used when an individual repeatedly disrupts the club. The will be given 3 chances to change their behavior. If the clubber continues to be disruptive, they will be taken to the commander who will notify the parents.

Dues

Dues are collected yearly to pay for the child's uniform/shirt and his or her handbook. A letter will be sent home with the prices. If your family is unable to pay the clubber dues, please contact Doug Watson for church sponsorship. Please do not let the cost hinder your child's participation.

What is AWANA?

Awana is a nondenominational program, used in reaching boys and girls with the gospel of Jesus Christ and training them to serve him. The name **AWANA** stands for **A**pproved **W**orkmen **A**re **N**ot **A**shamed coming from **2 Timothy 2:15**:

Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth (KJV)

We will have an Awana club meeting each week in which children will play games, memorize scripture, hear Bible stories and receive awards and recognition for their hard work.

Clubbers earn points if they:

- Wear their uniform
- Bring a Bible
- Bring their Handbook
- Recite Bible Verses
- Attend Sunday Small Groups
- Bring Friends
- Participation

Attendance
