

# Network Youth Summer Camp FAQ

## 1. Who can attend?

- Any student who is currently attending Revo or OneEighty

## 2. What are the dates?

- Camp starts on Thursday August 1<sup>st</sup> and goes to Sunday August 4<sup>th</sup>.
- Wednesday July 31<sup>st</sup> and Monday August 5<sup>th</sup> are travel days to/from Vine Church

## 3. Where is the Camp?

## 4. How much does it cost?

- \$380 per student (includes airfare, buses, meals, lodging, and registration)
  - o Blue Sky has setup a youth scholarship fund to help offset travel cost to make it affordable for all of our students to go.
- Payment and forms must be received together, on or before **May 31<sup>st</sup>**.

## 5. Can I sponsor a student to attend?

- Absolutely! You can write a check to Blue Sky Church with Youth camp in memo. You can drop that in the offering basket or black offering boxes at your convenience.

## 6. How can I register?

- Forms can be turned in to Aaron Knuth or in the offering baskets/boxes.

## 7. What is the deadline for registration?

- We will be booking airfare on June 1<sup>st</sup>, registration ends May 31<sup>st</sup>.

## 8. When do I need to drop off my student? When will they return?

- Drop-off and pick-up your student at Blue Sky Church.
- **Check-in @ 9:00 AM on Wednesday, July 31<sup>st</sup>**.
- **Students will be back around 11 PM on Monday, Aug. 5<sup>th</sup>**

## 9. What do I pack?

- Baggage limit: one carry-on & one personal item (purse, backpack)
  - *we will not be checking luggage for the flight*
  - Please have luggage tagged prior to arriving at check in
- **Pillow Case & Bedding**
  - **(sleeping bags and pillows will be provided)**
- Money for meals @ the airport (during travel)
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, etc)
- Bible & Notebook
- Sunscreen
- Snacks
- Towels
- Swim attire (one piece for girls; shirt for guys)
  - Modest tankinis are ok.
- Athletic clothing for recreation and free time
- Tennis shoes
- Jacket (A/C during sessions can be cold!)
- Laundry bag for messy clothes

### What DON'T I pack?

- Pranks
- ANY gaming device
- MP3 players are okay for rooms only
- Tobacco products/alcohol/drugs\*
- Weapons/Fireworks/Lighters/Matches\*

\*Possession of these items will result in your student being sent home or picked up at your expense.

## 10. Will someone administer medicine for my student?

- We ask that students monitor and administer their own medication
- Please indicate that on registration forms and also at check-in

## 11. Will my student be able to take their cell phone?

- Blue Sky Students will be allowed to use their phones during travel to/from Carbondale. Once at Vine Church the leaders will collect phones till we return from camp.
  - We believe this camp has the potential to be life-changing. We want to eliminate ANYTHING that might be a distraction to our students focusing on God and building relationships with others.
