Responsibilities/Duties:

- Attend a technical training session prior to becoming an Instructor/Facilitator
- Know & apply the mission of Manitoqua's Adventure Zone.
- Facilitate various groups through the Low Ropes, Low Initiatives, Climbing Tower, Zip Line and/or High Ropes programs
- Be flexible to adjust to various needs of participants
- Assist in planning programs for groups you facilitate
- Be prepared to share the gospel with person's you have contact with at Manitoqua
- Set-up and Take-down of supplies needed and used for your group for that day
- Abide by the safety guidelines of Manitoqua and the inspecting company
- Communicate with other facilitators and the Outdoor Education Coordinator of your needs as well as needs of the Adventure Zone
- Perform other reasonable duties as requested by the Outdoor Education Coordinator
