

A Typical Tuesday Schedule | Explorer (3rd – 6th)

TIME	ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION
7:15	Extended Care Begins	drop-off
8:15	Drop-off Begins; Shelter Activities & Playground Time	drop-off; introduction and warm-up activities for the day
9:00	Shelter Gathering	attendance, introduction to camp & the day's events, as well as get-to-know-you activities
9:20	Bible Time	activities that engage children in learning about God and His character through songs, skits or dramas, small group discussion, and prayer
10:00	Interest Groups or Adventure Zone	various day camp groups participate in either interest groups: range of activities where campers pursue an area of their own interest or visit the adventure zone: team building exercises, low-ropes course, zip line, climbing wall, or high ropes course
11:00	Themed Activities or Adventure Zone	various day camp groups participate in either themed activities: the past has seen lumberjack day, ninja day, and water week among other things or visit the adventure zone: team building exercises, low-ropes course, zip line, climbing wall, or high ropes course
12:00	Lunch	campers bring their own sack lunch; Manitoqua provides milk
12:30	Playground Time	
1:00	Free Time	campers have the option to visit: the aquatic center, game room, pickle shack, camp store, pond, basketball courts, or art hut; all areas are supervised with Manitoqua summer staff or lifeguards
3:00	Tournament	shelters establish their team identity as they prepare for various games
3:40	Story Time	exploration of literature with times of individual & group reading
4:00	Pick-up Begins; Shelter Activities & Playground Time	sign out at shelters with cool down activities during pick-up
5:00	Extended Care Begins	sign out in lower level dining hall
