

## Wisdom Warm-Up


Questions:

## Questions for discussion:

3. What is a **fool** according to Scripture? Discuss what you learn about being a fool in Proverbs 1 to help you define **fool**.

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Read Luke 11:39,40. Jesus says they are *foolish* and *hypocrites*. The meaning of *hypocrite* is *one who wears a mask, an actor*. How does this relate to being a fool in God's eyes?


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
