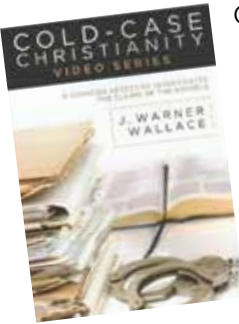
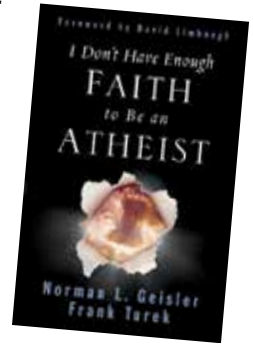
I Don't Have Enough Faith To Be an Atheist

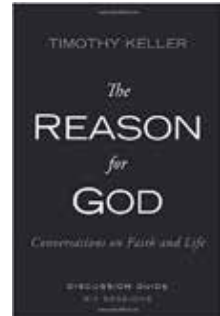
