MILEPOST 3

PRE-ADOLESCENCE

“Preparing for Adolescence”

(Target age: 10-12 yrs.)

Milepost Focus:

Identity in Christ, Spiritual growth, Spiritual disciplines, Looking at today’s culture, Identity and self-worth, Decision making, Gaining the trust of the parent

Scripture:

Psalms 139:1-18, Jeremiah 29:11, Genesis 1:27, Romans 8:28-29

Church Life:

- 1) Parenting and Marriage Seminars

- 2) Preparing for Adolescence seminar

On an annual basis we will offer a seminar for parents for pre-teens/teens that will cover topics such as: changes that occur during adolescence, struggles that are common to adolescence, adolescent culture, and how to practically lead your child spiritually through these crucial years.

- 3) 6th Grade Overnighter

A big question that middle school students try to figure out is “Who am I?” Soon after joining the middle school group we’ll invite all the 6th graders to an overnighter at the church that will be filled with games, food, and fun times, but most importantly we will spend time talking about how their identity is found in Christ—and we will introduce them to the ins and outs of middle school youth group.

Family Life:

- 1) Road Trip

Recommended Resource: James Dobson CD series “Preparing for Adolescence”

Purpose of this event is to facilitate a fun weekend between father/son; mother/daughter in which you are able to spend significant time talking about important issues such as physical changes, puberty, sex, emotions, and the importance of making choices that honor God. The destination should be centered on something that you and your child find enjoyable and are able to bond around (i.e. sporting event, camping trip, shopping trip, etc.). A great tool for this trip is the James Dobson CD series “Preparing for Adolescence”. During the drive time you can play through the Dobson CD’s as a starting point for many of the subjects you hope to talk about with your pre-teen.

MILEPOST 4

“Guiding My Child into Purity”

(Target age: 10-14 yrs.)

Milepost Focus:

Biblical purity, healthy relationships, biblical sex, the world’s perversion of sex, choosing friends wisely

Scripture:

Psalm 101:3, Proverbs 5:3-5, Proverbs 6:25-27, Job 31:11-12, Matthew 5:29-30, Matthew 15:10-20, Romans 6:12-14, 1 Corinthians 6:12-20, 1 Corinthians 10:13, Galatians 5:16-26, Ephesians 5:1-21, Colossians 3:5-6, 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8; 2 Timothy 2:22, Hebrews 13:4

Church Life:

- 1) Purity for Life Event

We will annually have a Purity for Life Event for our students which will tackle subjects such as: sex from biblical perspective, consequences of sex outside of marriage, God’s plan for sex vs. world’s abuse of sex.

Family Life:

- 1) Purity Ring Ceremony

The family celebration for Milepost 4 includes you presenting your son/daughter with a ring. The ring symbolizes purity in their life. It is meant to be a constant reminder of the strength and grace God gives to walk in purity in obedience to Him. A special family meal is a perfect opportunity for the Purity Ring Celebration. For your particular child their might be a better symbol other than a ring like a necklace, bracelet, etc.

- *Make the ceremony unique to your family*
- *Present the ring to your student*
- *Verbally clarify the commitment being made*
- *Reinforce your support*
- *Continue to pray for purity with your child throughout their life*
