

EVALUATION QUESTIONS FOR MISSIONS SUPPORT CANDIDATES

PROVIDE A BRIEF, BUT REASONABLY COMPLETE ANSWER TO THE FOLLOWING QUESTIONS:

Personal biographical information including birthdays, children's names etc. (if not previously provided)

Share your basic testimony concerning personal acceptance of Jesus Christ as Savior and description of your Christian growth. Husband and wife separately.

Briefly (in 3 to 5 sentences) state your doctrinal position regarding the following:

- a. The Virgin Birth
- b. Depravity of man and his hope for salvation.
- c. What is your view of justification? (a person's standing with Christ).
- d. What is your view of sanctification? (how does a person grow spiritually).
- e. What is the "gospel"?
- f. The Trinity
- g. Heaven and Hell
- h. The Inspiration of Scripture
- i. The Local and Universal Church

Discuss your calling to missionary service and your motivations for pursuing that call.

What do you want to see happen spiritually in the lives of the people you are going to serve?

Discuss your educational background and work experience that qualifies you for the missionary work you are pursuing.

Describe the specific work that you will be doing.

State your total financial need, how it is calculated and the current unmet amount.

What is the geographical makeup of your present support base? Ratio of churches:individuals?

If you have not already done so, tell us where you will be serving and when you plan to go/return to that field.

Briefly describe your present local church involvement
