Grow - A willingness by the student to attend programs that spiritual growth is emphasized and pushed. (Some of our grow level events are

Disciple - A desire by the student to take initiative for their own spiritual growth

Develop - A willingness to assume responsibility for other students spiritual growth. At this level we identify and develop their gifts and abilities to do ministry.
