March 8 – John 4:35-36 (ESV)

Do you not say, ‘There are yet four months, then comes the harvest?’ Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes and see that the fields are white for harvest. Already the one who reaps is receiving wages and gathering fruit for eternal life, so that the sower and reaper may rejoice together.

March 15 – John 5:39-40 (ESV)

You search the Scriptures because you think that in them you have eternal life; and it is they that bear witness about Me, yet you refuse to come to Me that you may have life.

March 22 – John 6:35 (ESV)

Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life; whoever come to Me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in Me shall never thirst.”

March 29 – John 6:37-39 (ESV)

All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and whoever comes to Me I will never cast out. For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will but the will of Him who sent Me. And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that I should lose nothing of all that He has given Me, but raise it up on the last day.

April 5 – John 7:37-38 (ESV)

On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. Whoever believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, ‘Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.’”

February 22 – John 3:36 (ESV)
