II. Setup Discussion – All of Scripture is All about Jesus

A. The Road to Emmaus – Luke 24:13-49

- Cleopas and another Disciple – Walking from Jerusalem to Emmaus (7 miles)
- Jesus joins them – (v.17) Asks, “What are you talking about?”
- Disciples – (v.18) Says, “Do you not know the things that have happened?”
- Read Luke 24:19-27 – Key Verse (v.27)
- Disciples comments – (v.32) “Did not our hearts burn within us while He spoke”
- Jesus appears to all His disciples – demonstrates that it is Him.
- Read Luke 24:44-49 – Key Verses (vv.44-47)
- So what is Jesus saying, *“All of Scripture is all about Jesus”*

B. Jesus With the Unbelieving Religious Leaders – John 5:37-47

- Context – Healing the man who has been an invalid for 38 years – Pool of Bethesda
- Read John 5:14-18 – Religious leaders want to kill Jesus – Why? – Healing on the Sabbath
- Read John 5:37-47 – Key Verses (vv.39-40) and (v.46)
- (v.39) – meaning – religious leaders think they can obtain eternal life by keeping the Law
- Law-Keeping – works-based righteousness
- So what is Jesus saying, *“All of Scripture is all about Jesus”*

C. What does that mean that All of Scripture is all about Jesus?

- Direct Prophecy
 - Genesis 3:15 – He will be the seed of the woman who crushes the seed of the Serpent *“you will bruise Him on the heel, He will bruise your head”*
 - Genesis 12:3 – All the nations of the earth will be blessed through Him
 - Deuteronomy 18:15 – He will be a prophet like Moses
 - Micah 5:2 – He will be born in Bethlehem
 - Isaiah 7:14 – He will be born of a virgin
 - 2 Samuel 7:16 – He will have a throne and a kingdom that will last forever
 - Isaiah 9:6-7 – He will be called “Wonderful Counselor, Almighty God, Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace and will have an eternal kingdom
 - Zechariah 9:9-10 – He will ride into Jerusalem on a donkey, righteous and having salvation and yet coming with humility and gentleness
 - Psalm 16:10 – He will be resurrected from the grave, body not suffer decay
 - Daniel 7:13-14 – He will come again from the clouds of heaven as the Son of Man
 - Malachi 4:2 – He will be the “Sun of Righteousness” for all who revere Him and look for His coming again
 - Isaiah 53:5 – He will be pierced through for our transgressions, crushed for iniquities
 - Isaiah 53:9 – He will die among the wicked ones but will be buried with the rich
 - Acts 8:26-35 – Philip told him the good news about Jesus

- Another Form of Prophecy – Still Prophecy – But Seen in Types And Shadows
 - How do we know that “*Types*” are a real thing?
 - Genesis 22:1-14 – Abraham Sacrificing of Isaac – Review the Story
 - Hebrews 11:17-18 – Abraham received Isaac back as a type of resurrection
- What kinds of types are there in the Old Testament? What categories should we be thinking about when we read through our Old Testaments?

1. Events

- Creation
 - Everything is formless and void [it’s dead] until God speaks the Word (John 1:1) “*In the beginning was the word and the word and the word was with God and the word was God. All things were made through Him and without Him was NOT anything made that was made. In Him was life and the life was the light of men... (v.14) and the word became flesh and dwelt [tabernacled] among us.*”
 - Jesus is the Word – the agent of creation – and what’s accomplished – light and life
 - Salvation – those who are dead in sin are made alive “by grace through faith in Christ”, which is a miraculous work of God – new creation – 2 Corinthians 4:4-6
- Jesus is our Sabbath Rest – 6 days of creation – 7th day for rest – Hebrews 4
- Flood – Salvation in the midst of Judgment – Through one man – Noah
 - Noah points to Jesus – just think about his description – “*blameless and righteous*”
 - Salvation only available through those who are “*in Him*”
- The Promises of God Through Abraham – Great Name, Great Nation, Great Blessing, Great Land
- Abraham Sacrificing Isaac – Genesis 22
- Passover Lamb – Exodus 12:1-20
- The Day of Atonement – Leviticus 16 – 2 goats – 1 goat sacrificed – 1 goat the scape goat
- David and Goliath – lowly shepherd boy from Bethlehem defeats an enemy whom on earth has no equal so that the people of God are freed up to plunder the enemy
- Jonah in the belly of the fish – Matthew 12:38-41

2. People Point Forward to Jesus

- Adam – Jesus is the 2nd Adam – Romans 5
- Enoch – “*Walked with God and was no more*”
- Noah – Salvation only through those who are “*in Him*” – blameless and righteous
- Abraham – Promise / Fulfillment – NOT in Abraham – But in Christ
- Melchizedek – thee mysterious King of Peace and Priest who has no beginning or end
- Isaac – The Promised Son – Miraculous Birth – Offered up by His father on the alter
- Joseph – Picture of death, burial, and resurrection – humiliation and exaltation
- Sampson – accomplished more through his death than through his life
- Solomon – Matthew 12:42 – “*The queen of the South will rise up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon, and behold, something greater than Solomon is here.*”
- King David – a man after God’s own heart

3. Places

- Tabernacle – place where man meets God
- Temple – Matthew 12:6 – *“something greater than the temple is here”*
- Temple – John 2:18-19 – *“Destroy this temple and in 3 days I will raise it up!”*

4. Offices

- Prophet – Jesus is the one true Prophet who speaks the Word of the Lord to the people
- Word that the Prophet speaks – Jesus is also the one true Word of God – (John 1:1)
- Priest – Jesus is the one true High Priest who intercedes with God on behalf of the people, who offers Himself as the *“once for all”* sacrifice – and then sits down at the right hand of God Almighty – O.T. priests never sat down – (Hebrews 10)
- Sacrifice – Jesus is the once for all sacrifice which is why He could sit down at God’s right hand
- King – Jesus is the one true King – all the good kings point to Him in a positive way, but all the wicked kings also point forward to Jesus in a negative way.
- Israelite – Jesus is also the one true Israelite – the who keeps the Law perfectly

5. Law / 10 Commandments

- Jesus is the fulfillment of the 10 commandments
- He fulfills the Law perfectly in every regard – Matthew 5:17-18
- Jesus fulfills the Law in His teaching – Jesus is the Greater than Moses – Matthew 2-4
- Jesus teaching – Sermon on the Mount – *“You have heard that it was said, but I say to you.”*
- Jesus fulfills the Law in keeping the Law perfection – 2 Corinthians 5:21 – *“without sin”*
- Jesus fulfills the Law in being cursed for those who don’t keep it – Galatians 3:10-14
