Christ Church PCA is committed to helping those who need financial assistance. The church has limited financial resources to manage and has developed criteria on how that help is given. We believe it is important that you receive spiritual counseling along with financial help. That is why we need to ask you questions that pertain to your spiritual status as well as your financial status.

What You Need to Know Before the Meeting

- There is **no guarantee** that you will receive financial assistance from the church. Completing this form and meeting the requirements does not obligate the church to provide assistance.
- Money is paid only to the business, service provider, or organization that is owed (i.e. Reliant Energy, landlord, medical clinic, etc.).
- We cannot make payment arrangements or make a payment plan for you in regards to the above.
- We only provide assistance for items that are necessities.
- We fully expect you to use all available financial means at your disposal to meet your needs.
- We do not give out cash. We have other means available to meet needs for food and transportation.
- We cannot guarantee same-day assistance. Please make other arrangements if you need immediate help.
- We do not give out a guaranty or agency pledge.
- We do not allow our members to be approached individually for assistance.

If you are seeking assistance, you will need to meet with two deacons. The meeting will be at the end of our Sunday morning worship service. We meet for worship at **9:30AM** at the above address. We encourage you to join with us in worship if you are able. The deacons will need to meet with you for about 30 minutes.

What You Need to Bring to the Meeting

- Name, address, phone number, and account number of the business, service provider, or organization to which you owe money – latest bill would be best.
- We will need proof of any payment arrangements you have made or tried to make in reference to the above.
- Address and phone number of where you can be reached.
- Valid ID (i.e. driver's license).
- Name, address, and phone number of current employer or previous employer (if currently unemployed).
- Name, address, and phone number of any churches and other non-profit organizations from which you have received financial assistance within the past 6 months.
- Name and phone number of your current pastor (if you attend church). We reserve the right to assist through your local/current church.
- If you have a medical condition that prevents either full-time or part-time employment, we need to see the latest determination letter from your doctor.
- If you are currently unemployed, we need to see recent efforts you have made to seek employment (i.e. job training, career counseling, job interviews).
- If you are on short-term or long-term leave from work, we need to know the circumstances.

What the Church Will Do After the Meeting

- We will review the above information.
- We will notify you of our decision within one week.
- We reserve the right to amend these requirements as needed.
