Pastor Matt, Kayla, Micah, Julia, Elliot and Amelia are moving to Denver, CO, to begin their training as church planters. God has been working in their hearts for a long time, growing their desire to take the gospel into places where people have not heard about the love of Jesus. The Hornes were a part of a local church plant in Mbale, Uganda, when God began burdening them for the United States. After much prayer, they returned to Casper, WY, where Pastor Matt has served as an associate pastor here at Cornerstone for nearly three years. Cornerstone has been an incubator for God to work in their hearts, and they praise God for that.

In Denver they will join The Calvary Family of Churches which has planted 14 churches in Colorado, Idaho, and Nebraska. During the first year in Denver, the Hornes will spend time immersed in the various church plants around Denver, going to weekly trainings, and working through church planting assessments. Then they will begin exploring where God might send them. Currently, they would like to stay around Denver, as it is the fastest growing city in the country and there are countless neighborhoods that have no substantial gospel witness.

Please pray with the Hornes! Pray first and foremost that they would be obedient to the Lord to take the gospel to people in their new apartment complex, and that they would stay close to the Lord on a daily basis. Pray for their children that God would comfort them during the transition. The Hornes need to raise financial support, so pray that God would supply all that they need. Pray for their training and that they can build strong relationships with the Calvary Church in Englewood where they will worship. The Hornes would like to express their deep gratitude for the support and encouragement of Cornerstone. God has shown His love through many of you which has blessed them tremendously.
