



## PART TIME CHILDREN'S MINISTRY DIRECTOR

### Purpose of Position:

The Children's Ministry Director will lead a volunteer team that teaches children (from ages birth to 6<sup>th</sup> grade) about the characteristics of our creator God, the life of our Savior Jesus Christ, the present help we have in the Holy Spirit and power of His Word. The team will encourage children to live a life that glorifies God and encourage/equip parents to live out their faith at home with children.

- 25 hours a week for 40 weeks (September through mid June/VBS) +
- 10 hours a week for 12 weeks (mid June/after VBS through August)

### Responsibilities:

1. Responsible to the Board of Elders and working directly under the supervision of the Senior Pastor
2. Responsible for the oversight and leadership of the Children's ministries that include: Wednesday Night Kids Club, Children's Church, Sunday School, Special Events, Vacation Bible School, Nursery, Family Zone, Home School Co-op.
3. Recruit, train pray for and involve new volunteers
4. Create and effectively manage the ministry's budget.
5. Communicate consistently with parents.
6. Carry out all the tasks related to its ministry as outlined in its mission statement and help create the vision of ministry and annually prepare goals and objectives.
7. Be empowered to establish team(s) as approved by the GROW committee to meet objectives.

### Teacher and Volunteer Expectations:

- Live a life in and out of the church that demonstrates a commitment to God and visible dedication to His Word
- Committed to being available to as many events and studies that they are leading and assisting as they can
- Demonstrate a willingness to be teachable to those they are working alongside and working under
- Accepts correction when it is done with love and kindness
- Committed to pray for each child they are teaching/leading and pray for their parents as they raise their child
- To attend church while they are serving
- Agree with the Mission and Vision statement of the Children's Ministry Team
