1. Wayne Grudem defines trinity this way, "God eternally exists as three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and each person is fully God, and there is one God." In your own words, describe how you have understood and would articulate the doctrine of the trinity
2. The Bible teaches the following three things, which of them is the most difficult for you to believe, understand or articulate?
 1. God is three persons.
 2. Each person is fully God
 3. There is one God
3. The doctrine of the trinity, as with many doctrines, requires the Christian to hold in tension several ideas that do not contradict one another but do pull on each other. Can you think of any other doctrines that create a similar tension?
4. What is a good example of a scripture that demonstrates the "three-ness of the trinity? What are some characteristics of each person?
5. Why does it matter that the trinity is three distinct persons?
6. Is it difficult to believe that each person of the trinity is fully and equally divine? Why or why not?
7. Do you find that you interact with each person of the trinity, either in prayer, study or obedience as if there were a hierarchy or that one or more persons of the trinity were more divine?
8. After talking through these questions, would you change your answer to the first question?
