3. Play and sing as a group at the same volume level, not seeking any glory for ourselves but all to the glory of God.
4. Strive daily to grow your relationship with Jesus Christ through daily quiet times, reading your Bible, and praying to Him throughout the day.
5. Avoid the appearance of evil. Conduct yourself with the utmost integrity in all situations. Live a life that is above reproach. You represent this church wherever you go!
6. Invest in people’s lives inside and outside the church, sharing the true gospel of Jesus Christ.
7. Attend church services and special events setting an example to others, even if you’re not required.
8. Punctuality is important in a successful rehearsal. Be at church ready to play/sing before the designated time to insure that we start on time!
9. If you have a problem or need to address an issue please notify the worship pastor. Gossiping, talking about an issue, or talking about somebody behind his or her back will not be tolerated. Loyalty to the vision and staff is crucial to protect the unity we have on the team and growth potential.
10. If consistent violations of any of these policies occur, you may be removed from the worship team.

This contract is not to intimidate you, but to insure that we are each held to a higher standard because we are all leaders of God. As Romans 12:1 states *“Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, **holy and pleasing** to God—this is your true and proper worship.” NIV*
