

Devotion 2 “Share the Good News”

Scripture Reading Romans 10”5-17

Paul states people are saved when they hear the clear message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and respond by God’s grace through faith that Jesus saves us from our sin and God’s wrath.

There’s a little bit of a potential problem. If people respond to the Gospel after they hear the Gospel preached, then somebody needs to tell them the Gospel so they can respond.

Paul uses the word preaching and preach in this passage. People get confused with these words and incorrectly think that Paul is talking about preachers or pastors. The command and privilege to preach the Good News is not just for pastors. This is for all Christ Followers. We are all given this incredible honor to share the life saving message that Jesus died for our sins and He arose to new life from the grave.

Object Lesson:

Supplies Needed:

Dominoes or wooden blocks

Lesson:

Everyone gets one domino.

Stand a domino at the end of a table.

Everyone gets one turn standing their domino at the other end of the table. They will then tip their domino over with the hope of knocking the other domino down. Obviously, they shouldn’t be able to knock the other domino down.

Now, have everyone stand dominoes up in a line or pattern from one end of the table reaching all the way to the first domino. Have fun knocking the first domino over and watch them all tip over and eventually knock the first domino over.

Questions/Discussion:

Why couldn’t you knock the first domino over with your domino?

What was different when we worked together?

This is how Jesus wants us all to take part in sharing the Good News of the Gospel. When we work together, more people get to hear the Good News.
