The Lord's Table

In the Lordø Supper we see, smell, touch and taste the Word. In the public reading and preaching of Scripture, God addresses our mind and conscience through the hearing. In the sacraments, He uniquely addresses our mind and conscience through the other senses. Godø promise is made tangible. God speaks through the bread and wine to remind us of His covenant of Grace. This sign and seal reminds us and assures us of a promise. That is, it points to and confirms a gracious promise of God to His people. Another way of saying it is that a sacrament is an action designed by God to sign (symbolize) and seal (ratify) a covenantal reality, accomplished by the power and grace of God, the significance of which has been communicated by the word of God, and the reality of which is received or entered into only by faith. Hence, the weakness, the frailty of human faith welcomes this gracious act of reassurance. All who come to The Table of the Lord in faith are nourished by the Spiritø work as they again embrace Godø promise signed and sealed. (taken in part from FPC-Jackson)
