*"...the Apostle presses upon Christian women firstly, that they should make conscience of duty to their husbands, though they were pagans, that so they might be gained to fall in love with Christianity by the sight of their chaste and religious carriage; secondly, that they should not be much taken up with trimming of their bodies. But thirdly, that their prime care should be to have their souls adorned with grace, especially meekness: because that is an ornament durable: and it is high esteem with God.
