Today's text gives a response to those who know the truth but declare "we will follow our own plans and will everyone act according to the stubbornness of his evil heart" (v. 12). Perhaps in our day it might be expressed as a declaration that religious truth is whatever we believe to be true. But such a declaration of "my truth" is as much an affront to God's Word as what is seen in verse 12. Today's text allows us to see how we should respond to the bold rejection of God's Word so present in our age.

"To write the same things to you is no trouble to me and is safe for you. (Phil. 3:1)" Pastoral care includes a lot of repetition which is safe and helpful to the saints. Important things need to be repeated and so I am glad to once again invite your attendance at both of our Sunday Services. As Dr. Pipa reminded us recently, the Preaching of God's Word is central to the healthy life of the church and our own sanctification. We offer two services not to provide options but because we believe the preaching of God's Word is central to our growth in grace and the calling of the lost to Christ.
