Cash and the contents of the building will be transferred by the Session to one or several churches or Christian ministries that the Session selects. The church property must be disposed of with the approval of the congregation which may happen with the transfer of the title to another church or Christian ministry or the sale of the property with the funds then being distributed by the Session of another church or Christian ministry.*
