## **Some of the Expectations of Infant Baptism**

The following, from our Book of Church Order, provides some helpful reminders for parents, grandparents, and all who pledge their assistance in the nurturing of covenant children in the Church.

Parents should give attention to the careful performance of their duty, with the assistance and encouragement of the whole church, by doing the following:

1. That they teach the child to read the Word of God;
2. that they instruct him in the principles of our holy religion, as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, an excellent summary of which we have in the *Confession of Faith*, and in the *Larger and Shorter Catechisms* of the Westminster Assembly, which are to be recommended to them as adopted by the Church, for their direction and assistance, in the discharge of this important duty;
3. that they pray with and for him;
4. that they set an example of piety and godliness before him; and endeavor, by all the means of God's appointment, to bring up their child in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.

Parents are required to bind themselves to the faithful performance of Christian parenting by the affirmation of the following questions:

1. Do you acknowledge your child's need of the cleansing blood of Jesus Christ, and the renewing grace of the Holy Spirit?
2. Do you claim God's covenant promises in (his) behalf, and do you look in faith to the Lord Jesus Christ for (his) salvation, as you do for your own?
3. Do you now unreservedly dedicate your child to God, and promise, in humble reliance upon divine grace, that you will endeavor to set before (him) a godly example, that you will pray with and for (him), that you will teach (him) the doctrines of our holy religion, and that you will strive, by all the means of God's appointment, to bring (him) up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord?
