**Minister:** What is the moral law and where in the Bible can we find a summary of that law?

**Congregation:** The moral law is the declaration of the will of God to mankind, directing and binding everyone to personal, perfect, and perpetual conformity and obedience thereunto: promising life upon the fulfilling, and threatening death upon the breach of it.

The moral law is summarily comprehended in the ten commandments, which were delivered by the voice of God upon Mount Sinai, and written by him in two tables of stone; and are recorded in the twentieth chapter of Exodus. The four first commandments containing our duty to God, and the other six our duty to man.

**Minister:** What special use is there of the moral law to the regenerate who believe in Christ?

**Congregation:** It shows them how much they are bound to Christ for his fulfilling the law and enduring its curse in their place; and thereby to provoke them to more thankfulness and the expression of that thankfulness in their obedience.
