From Heidelberg Catechism 40-43

Minister: Why was it necessary for Christ to suffer death and why was He buried?

Congregation: Because the justice and truth of God required that satisfaction for our sins could be made in no other way than by the death of the Son of God. And He was buried to show thereby that He was really dead.

Minister: Since, then, Christ died for us, why must we also die and what further benefit do we receive from the sacrifice and death of Christ on the cross?

Congregation: Our death is not a satisfaction for our sin, but only a dying to sin and an entering into eternal life. And we benefit further from Christ's sacrifice and death because it is by His power that our old man is with Him crucified, slain, and buried; so that the evil lusts of the flesh may no more reign in us, but that we may offer ourselves unto Him a sacrifice of thanksgiving.
