MAIN IDEA: David, as the Lord's anointed, provides for others as the Lord has provided for him.

II. David's provision for others (vv. 22:1-2, 6-23)

Questions for further study and community discussion

1. How do we see God provide for David in 21:1-15 and 22:3-4? How does David interpret these events in Psalms 34 and 56?

2. What is the contrast we find between Saul and David in 22:1-2, 6-23? How is Jesus the anti-Saul and the perfect David? How should Jesus' provision and sacrifice lead us to love and care for others?
