Questions for further study and community discussion

1. Why is Nabal the way he is in this passage? What does our use of money and possessions say about our hearts?
2. How do we see the wisdom of Abigail in this passage? What does David's respond to Abigail teach us? What does a lack of teachability say about us?
3. How does God work for David in this text? How is Jesus better and different than David? How should we live in light of God's grace?
