**MAIN IDEA:** David perseveres in prayer, with confidence, because he knows the Lord is his strength.

I. David's prayer (vv. 1-5)

II. David's confidence (vv. 6-9)

### Questions for personal study and community discussion

1. What do we learn about prayer from vv. 1 and 2?
2. Why should David's petition about the wicked in vv. 3-5 cause us to consider our own lives?
3. How does David's prayer turn from a cry to one of confidence? What does he remember and why is that important for us as well?
4. How does this psalm find its fulfillment in Christ? (Hint: think about vv. 8-9.)
