Family Focus

CONNECT • GROW • FOLLOW



A couple of years ago, I had the opportunity to hear a woman named Immaculé give her testimony. Immaculé is a survivor of the Rwandan genocide of the mid-1990's. On April 6, 1994, the President of Rwanda was killed when his plane was shot down. The President was a member of the Hutu tribe, and so the government and Hutu militiamen implemented an already-existing plan to exterminate the Tutsi minority. In the following 100 days, nearly 1 million Tutsis were killed.

When the killing started, Immaculé was sent to a Hutu pastor for protection. He hid her and seven other women in his family's master-bathroom, a 3x5 foot room for 91 days. They had to remain absolutely silent and that first night, the pastor had to feed them the left-overs from his children's dinner, rescued from the trash. All this, because their presence had to be hidden, even from the pastor's children.

During this time, Immaculé began to pray the Lord's Prayer. Yet, knowing that her family had been killed along with her entire village and most of her friends made praying "forgive us our sins as we forgive those who have sinned against us" impossibly difficult. Immaculé tried omitting that line, but was convicted about editing the Lord's own prayer. One voice suggested she forget about it, another encouraged her to "ask Me to help you pray that prayer." God taught her to pray that prayer from the heart.

One day a group of nearly 400 Hutu militiamen raided the pastor's house where Immaculé was being hidden. They checked the roof, hunted through the attic with flashlights, and searched room-by-room. As she and a few others hid in the master bathroom, Immaculé again heard two voices. One told her that she was going to die anyway, and should just run for it. The other voice reminded her "I made their eyes and ears, and there is nothing too hard for Me. Just ask Me to prevent them from seeing the door to the bathroom." Immaculé prayed, and after searching the master bedroom, the militiamen left.

God worked a miracle when He blinded the eyes of those Hutus. But He worked an even greater miracle in the heart of that young Tutsi woman. A few years later, Immaculé returned to Rwanda. There, she met the man who had killed her family, as he was in prison. She embraced him and told him that she had forgiven him in Jesus' name. This is the character of the One who said "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing." (Luke 23:34). That can only come from one who has met the man who first spoke those words, the Risen Son of God.
