Sunday AM Worship: **"Who is Jesus? Behold the Lamb!"**

As most of you know, this spring we are exploring the question "Who is Jesus?" In January and February, we "Followed His Signs." Now, we have entered into a second series called, "Behold the Lamb." In this series, we are going to be searching seven scripture passages from both the Old and the New Testaments to see what John the Baptist meant when he said, "Behold The Lamb of God!" Hope you can join us on Sunday mornings at 10am for this adventure.

Sunday PM Worship: **"Leaving Egypt Behind"**

Our evening services are smaller and more informal. We sing some hymns together and study the Bible. We are still working through the book of Exodus under the theme "Leaving Egypt Behind." We have come to the crossing of the Red Sea in chapter 14. These are some exciting stories and they have amazing applications to our lives. You are welcome to join us.

Wednesday PM Bible Study: **"Selected Psalms"**

We are studying selected Psalms. This month we are going to study Psalms 86, 89 and 91. Psalm 86 is a prayer of David. In this prayer he asks God to "Teach me Your way." Psalm 89 is a long Psalm containing 52 verses. We will break it up into two lessons, "I will sing of Your Love" (v.1-29) and "How long, O Lord?" (v.30-52). Our Study then for Psalm 91 is "The Shadow of The Almighty".
