

General Descriptions of Committees and Teams

- I. Baptismal Team – Assists the pastoral staff in preparing for the ordinance of baptism including the general maintenance of the baptistery.
- II. Bereavement Team – Coordinates the ministry to bereaved families of church members and the Sanger community.
- III. Stewardship Committee – Prepares the annual budget, provides budgetary oversight throughout the year, reviews and updates guidelines for spending, and helps educate all members about stewardship.
- IV. Building and Grounds Committee – Assists the church in matters relating to property administration including maintenance.
- V. Children’s Committee – Advises and assists the Children’s Director and other children’s organizational leaders in our church’s ministry to children in grades 1 through 6.
- VI. Committee on Committees – Nominates church members to serve on committees and teams who are then presented to the church for election.
- VII. Decoration Committee – Assists in seasonal and general décor of the church.
- VIII. Food Service Team – Assists in church activities and events involving food and assists in the maintenance and upkeep of the church kitchen.
- IX. Historical Team – Gathers and preserves the church’s records including recording of major events and milestones in the life of the church.
- X. Library Team – Assists in maintaining and staffing the church library.
- XI. Lord’s Supper Team – Prepares the elements and equipment for the observance of the Lord’s Supper.
- XII. Media Team – Provide technical assistance for church events including sound, lighting and computer. Works with church staff in maintaining the church website. Provides recommendations relating to the purchase of new equipment.
- XIII. Missions Committee – Evaluates and recommends potential mission projects while promoting the cause and directive of missions.
- XIV. Music Committee – Assists the Minister of Music in the ministry to members through music.
- XV. Nominating Committee – Coordinates the staffing of all church leadership positions to be filled by volunteers.
- XVI. Personnel Committee – Assists the church in matters relating to employed personnel.
- XVII. Preschool Committee – Advises and assists the Preschool Director and other children’s organizational leaders in our church’s ministry to children through age 5.
- XVIII. Recreation Committee – Supports the church staff member responsible for the overall church recreation program.
- XIX. Scholarship Committee – Brings recommendations regarding recipients of scholarships to the church body for approval.
- XX. Teller Team – Assists in the collection of offerings and tithes.
- XXI. Transportation Team – Serves as a service group responsible for the maintenance of church vehicles and to recommend purchases relating to vehicles.

*Committee members generally serve 3 year terms with 2 members rolling on and 2 members rolling off every year. Teams generally do not have set terms and members often serve for multiple years.
