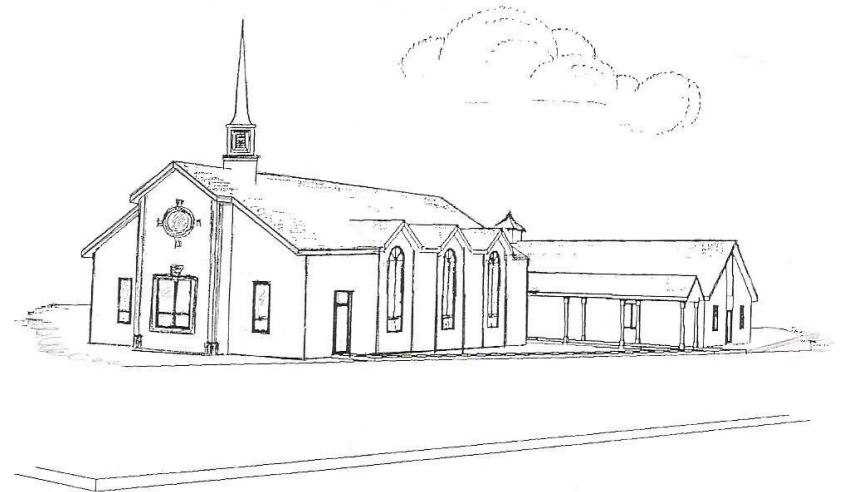

Sermon: **"Christ Thinks on His Future Joy"**

1 Corinthians 1:23

"Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory:
Luke 24:26.

Suffering was to precede Christ's glory. Besides, our comfort lies in His being an advocate. But how is He an advocate? With His blood in His hands. It is by His blood He speaks in heaven, and by His blood faith speaks to God. He paid the debt in His suffering, and pleads the payment in His glory. The payment went before the plea in order of nature; and our eyeing the payment precedes our eyeing the plea in order of faith. Christ without His garments rolled in blood, could not be answerable to God, nor acceptable to a sinner. Faith is therefore called faith in His blood. As faith is the instrument of justification, so it must eye the cause of our justification. And that is Christ's as groaning and offering up Himself to God a ransom, a righteousness for many. The curse upon Adam is the lash wherewith an angry conscience scourgeth a sinner. The freedom from this curse is only found in the vengeance God exacted of the

Redeemer for the sins of all that return to Him by repentance. Both the death and resurrection of Christ concur to the same end, that is our justification.

But the first act of applying faith is about Him as a bloody victim. As often as the Israelites were stung by the fiery serpents, they were to look up for health to the serpent lifted up, a type and emblem of the death of Christ. Upon every sin of a believer, the sacrifice is pleaded in heaven by the Priest, and ought in remembrance of it to be renewed in the repeated acts of our faith.
