As hungry, we feed on our Savior's broken body; as thirsty, we drink His precious blood. Here is a whole Christ—a perfect Savior. Here is nourishment for the soul, of which, if a man partake, he shall live forever. If I partake of the elements alone, they do me no good; but if, while

partaking of the elements, I partake of Christ by faith, I am strengthened, quickened, and nourished up into everlasting life. Precious, precious Savior! I will come to Thy table, that I may feed on Thy flesh and blood, so shall I live forever. Blessed Spirit, ever reveal and endear Jesus to me when I come to this feast of love. O for heartfelt communion with God, at His own table! "Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day: for my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed." -John 6:54,55.
