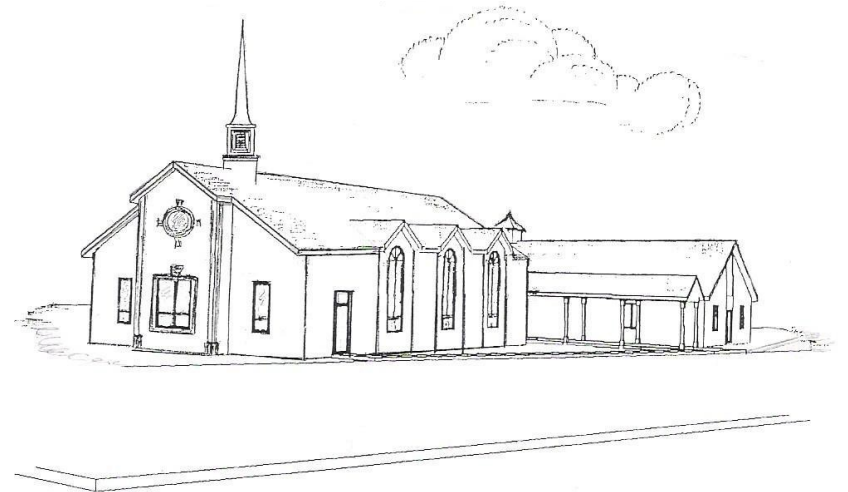

1 Corinthians 1:23

"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23

The sinner deserves to die for his sins. Since God is a just and righteous God, sin cannot absolutely escape unpunished. God must deny Himself to be unjust, but this He can never do. Sin is of an infinite guilt, and has an infinite evil nature in it. Therefore no person in heaven or on earth can procure the pardon of it or make satisfaction for it but the Lord Jesus, who is the God-man; who has infinite dignity. No prayers, no cries, no tears, no humblings, no repentings, no resolution and no reformations can stop the course of justice and procure the guilty sinner's pardon. It is Christ alone that can dissolve all obligations to punishment, and break all bonds and chains of guilt, and hand a pardon to us through His own blood. We are set free by the blood of Christ. The truth of God requires it. As God is just, He is also true, and must make good the threatenings that have gone out of His mouth: "In the day that thou eatest thereof

thou shalt surely die." (*Gen. 2:17*). God cannot break His word. O people, there is no standing before a God that is a consuming fire, a just judge, and a holy God, unless we have One that is mighty to undertake for us and satisfy divine justice; One mighty to pacify divine wrath, bear divine threatenings, and mighty to forgive sin! The Father is just in forgiving our sins (*1 John 1:9*) in Christ. The sentence of death against sinners who are denounced by the law was inflicted by God upon Christ! This satisfaction was most agreeable to divine wisdom. Since the fall of Adam, the only way sinners can appear in comfort before the justice of God is in the obedience and suffering of Jesus Christ, in the righteousness of our mediator. No other way can the justice of God be satisfied and our sins pardoned, but in Christ our righteousness! Jehovah-Tsidkenu, the Lord our righteousness!
