THE WILL OF GOD

"This is the will of God, even your sanctification." 1 Thess. 4: 3.

Every believer should prefer God's will to his own; and whenever he can discover what God's will is on any point, he should endeavor to carry it out. It is God's will that we should be holy. To this end, He chose us in Christ, *that we should be holy and blameless before Him in love.* To this end, we were redeemed, that we may *be a peculiar people, zealous of good works.* To this end, we were regenerated, *created anew in Christ unto good works.* Therefore the command is, *"Be ye holy, for I am holy."* God wishes us to be separate from the world, for sanctification is separation; separation from the world, for the worship and honor of God. Let us, therefore, keep ourselves distinct from the world, turning our back on its pleasures, amusements, and pursuits, and endeavor to carry out the admonition of the apostle, *"Whether therefore ye eat or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God."* Let us so live, so walk, so speak, and so act, as to convince all about us that we are the Lord's, set apart for Him, delighting to serve Him, diligently obeying Him, and aiming in all things to please Him. Whatever will deepen our sanctification, increase our conformity to Christ, and widen our separation from this present evil world, let us diligently pursue; and whatever will conform us to the world, fix our affections on the world, or carnalize our minds, let us carefully avoid. Like Caleb of old, may we have another spirit in us, that we may follow the Lord fully. The Lord loves to see us decided for Him, devoted to Him, and acting like

Him. Let us, therefore, imitate God, as His tenderly-beloved children, and seek in all things to resemble Him.
