The Spirit, which stirs us up to pray for ourselves, will, if we do not quench Him, send us on the same errand for others. In praying for others, get your heart deeply affected with their state and condition. Pouring out your soul shows greater love than drawing out your purse. Be sure your soul is poured out, or else you are a deceiver, and wrong God and those you pray for. Christ was troubled at the grave of Lazarus, and those about Him said, *'Behold how he loved him!'* You will pray fervently when your heart is warmed with sympathy. A lawyer may show rhetoric in pleading a man's case in court, but a dear friend will show more affection. And when you pray for others, prefer spiritual blessings over temporal. If health is all you beg for, you are not faithful to your friend. He may have that and yet be worse for it. Ask of Christ grace and glory for him, and you have something significant! Our Savior used this method with the paralytic. (*Matt 9:2*). First, He brought him news of a pardon, which

is of infinitely more worth than life or limbs. For the nation, aim at more than deliverance from outward judgments. The carnal Jews could ask for water, but didn't think about repentance for sin or pardon. The beast can bellow in a drought! Do not be discouraged in your prayers when the answer does not presently come if a rebellious child or carnal friend continues to be so. Don't give up the work! Don't take them out of your prayers, or think they are past grace because you see no sign of spiritual life in them. It is not too late for God to breathe life into them! A father's labor is not lost if his son receives the benefit of it! He may die before the ship he prays for comes home, but his child lives to have the gains of that adventure paid in his purse. One generation sows prayers, and another reaps the mercy prayed for!
