CHILDREN OF HONOR

Purpose

Honor up, Honor down, Honor all around

Thought to memorize:

“And a servant of the Lord must not be mean but be gentle to all”

LEARNING ACTIVITIES:

Invite a child to give the opening prayer.

LESSON:

Last week we learned what honor was. Can anybody tell me? That is right Honor is treating someone special because we see how special God made them! How did you show honor this past week?

For us to honor people we have to learn to see how special and unique they are. What is the word Unique? Unique means different, special, something that no one else has. Everyone is unique to God. Can you tell me what makes you so unique? Now tell me what makes someone else in this room so unique?

When we see how special everyone is, it helps us to be able to honor them no matter their age, height, color, looks, etc.

Sometimes it may seem hard to know exactly how to show love to other people. But Jesus gave us a rule to follow to help us. We are to treat others like we would like to be treated. How do you like to be treated? (Nicely, fairly, kindly, etc.) So we can treat others that way too. That is showing love and honor to them. We are to treat others the way we'd like to be treated.

OUTSIDE ACTIVITY:

Play the game “hot potato” But instead of playing music toss the ball to a child and when they catch it they have to say something unique about them, or a way they will honor others this week and then pass it to the next person. If they cannot think of something they can sit down until the game is over.
