4. What affected the disciples from remembering what Christ said they were going to do before they sailed to the other side?
5. How did the disciples respond (vs 25)?
6. What describes the life of this man in vs 29?
7. How did the demon-possessed man respond to his encounter with Jesus?
8. How did Jairus approach Jesus?
9. In addition to belief, what quality does the sick woman in vs 43-44 display?
10. What did she do when she couldn't go unnoticed (hint: the same thing as Jairus)?
11. What did Jesus say healed her?
12. In vs 49, what sought to wreck Jairus's hopes?
13. What did Christ encourage Jarius to do?
14. How did Jairus respond?
15. In all four situations, what was the one thing attempting to cause them to doubt?
16. What circumstances are surrounding you that are shouting, "Give up. All is lost. Save your time and sanity. Accept your circumstances."?
