

PRACTICAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS FOR YOUTH GROUP ON 28 FEB 18

Luke 6:43-7:10

- In the first illustration of verses 43-45, Jesus says each tree is recognized by its own fruit. What point is He trying to make to His disciples? What does the tree represent and what does the tree's fruit represent?
- In the second illustration, verses 46-49, what is the defining difference between the man in vs 48 and the man in vs 49?
- What three things did the man in vs 48 do (hint: look at vs 47)?
- Who is a centurion?
- Would you expect a centurion to be a follower of Christ?
- The centurion had heard of Jesus beforehand. Based on his awareness of who Jesus was, he correctly understood Christ to possess one key character trait. What trait was it (another hint: it's in vs 7)?
- When you hear the words "blind faith", what does that mean?
- Did the centurion have a "blind faith"? Should you have a "blind faith"?
- If you could pick one word to sum up the stories in vs 43-45, 46-49, and 1-9, what word would that be?
- What other verses in the bible support what Jesus Christ is teaching in this passage?
- In what area of your life has God helped you to walk as a faithful man or woman of action...one who practices what Christ teaches?
- In what area of your life are you like the foolish builder in vs 49, who doesn't act upon God's word? What is step one to make a change in this area of your life?
