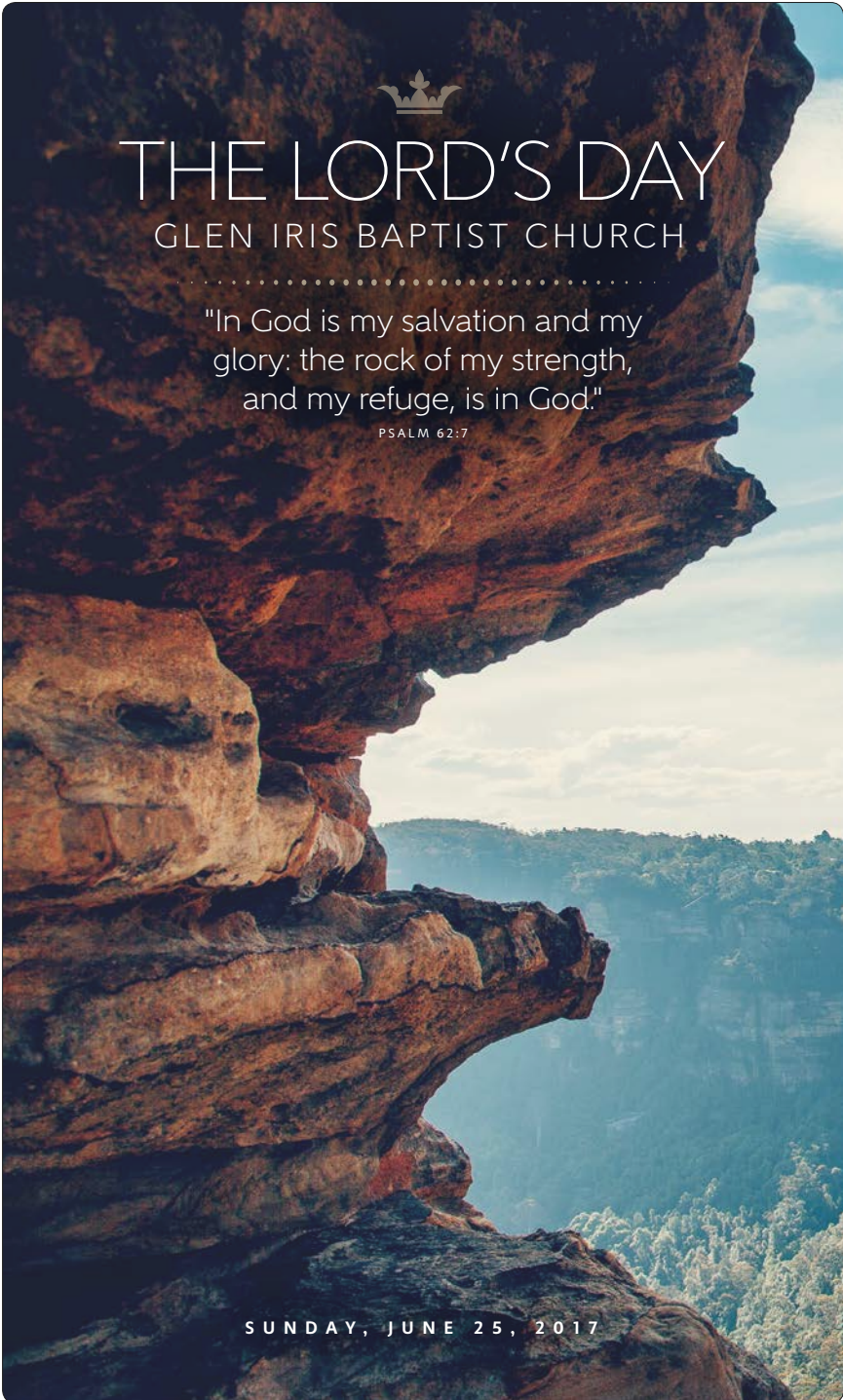
TABLE OF BLESSING
