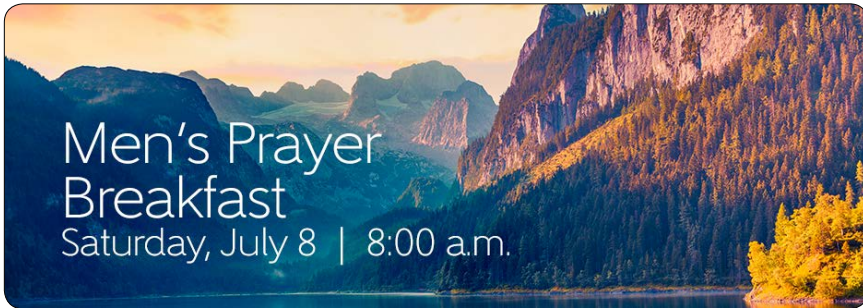

### WEDDING SHOWER

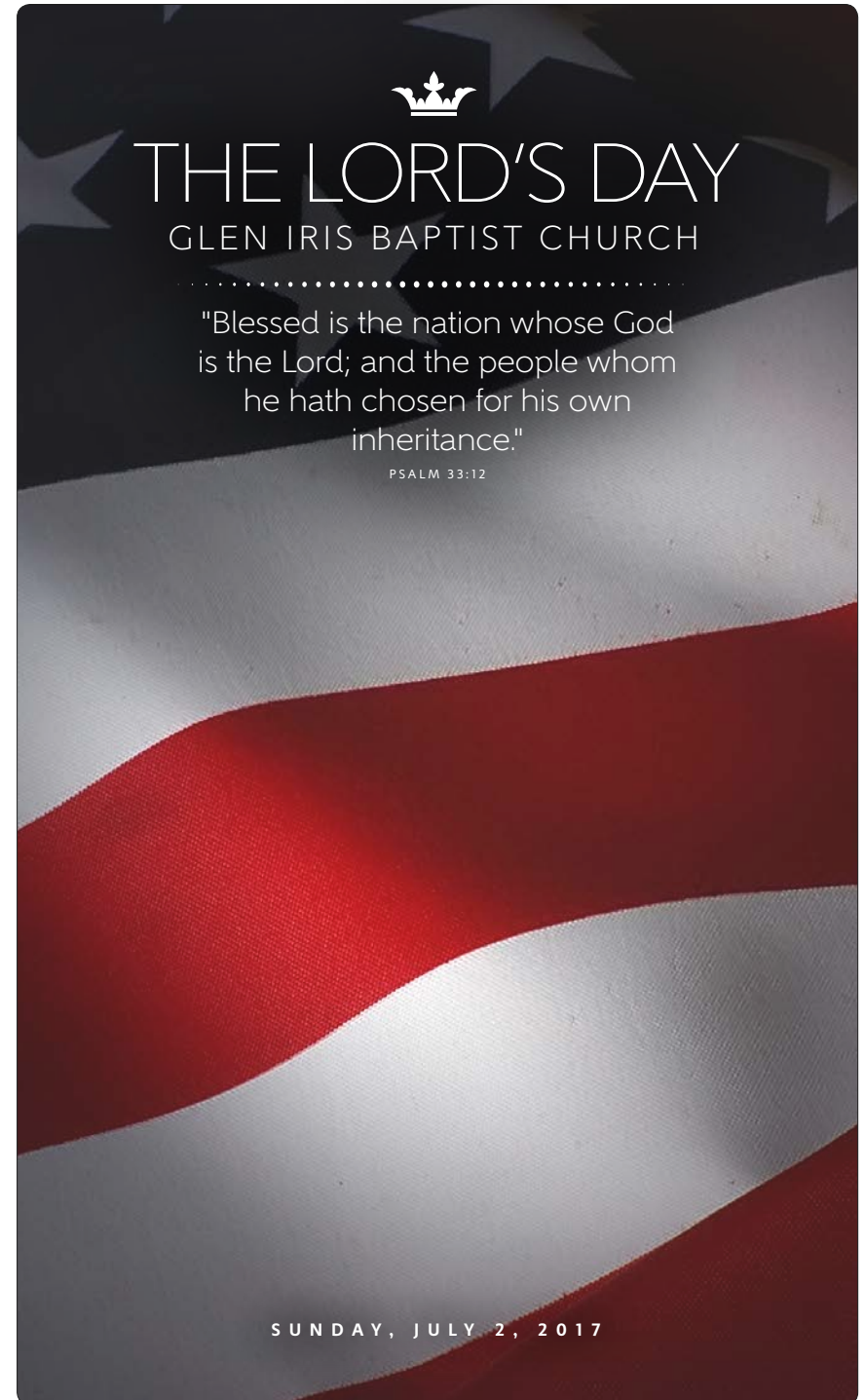
