Please pray that the Lord would bless this avenue of presenting the glorious gospel of Christ.

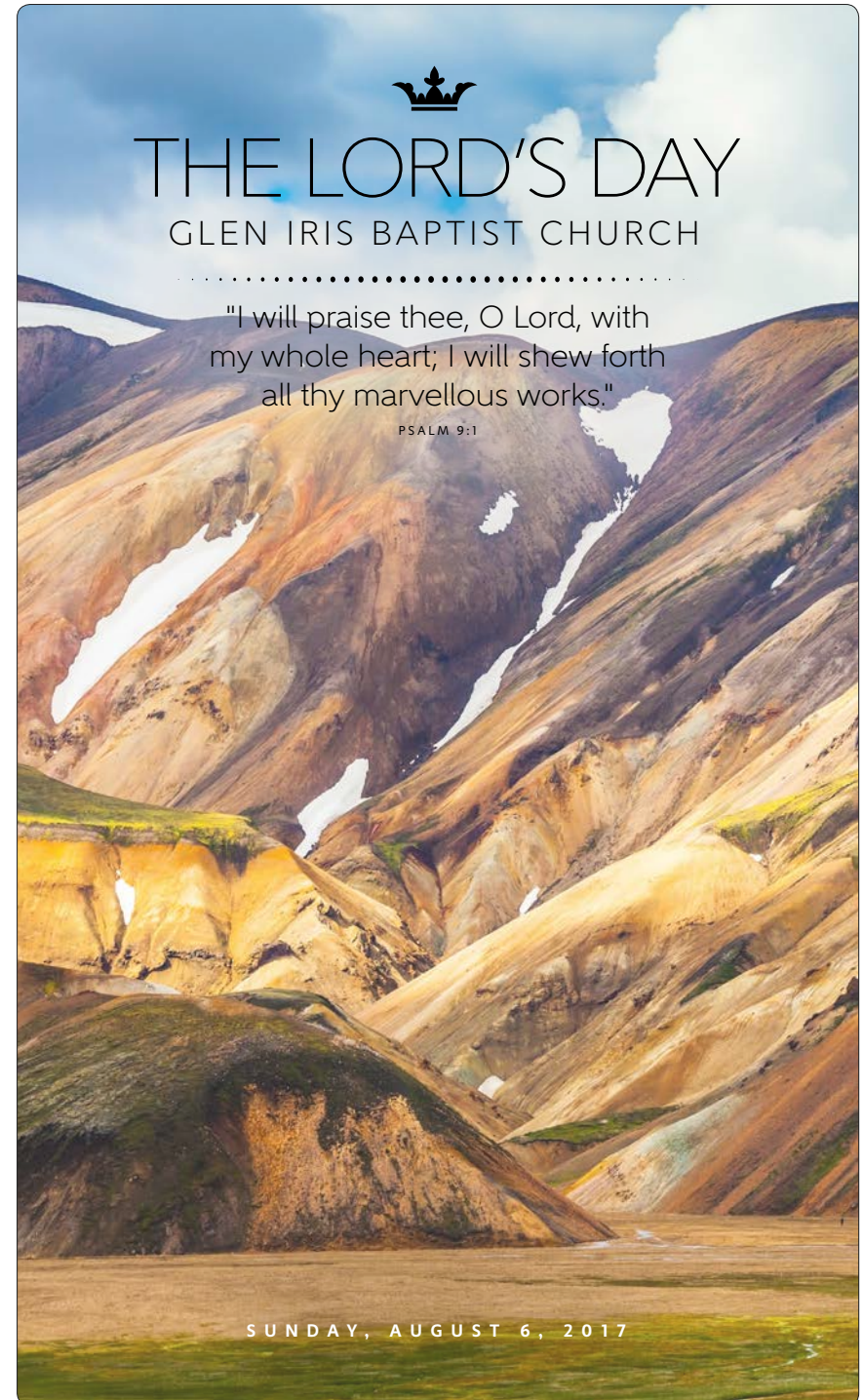
PRAYER REQUESTS
