WHERE ARE YOU ON WEDNESDAY EVENINGS?

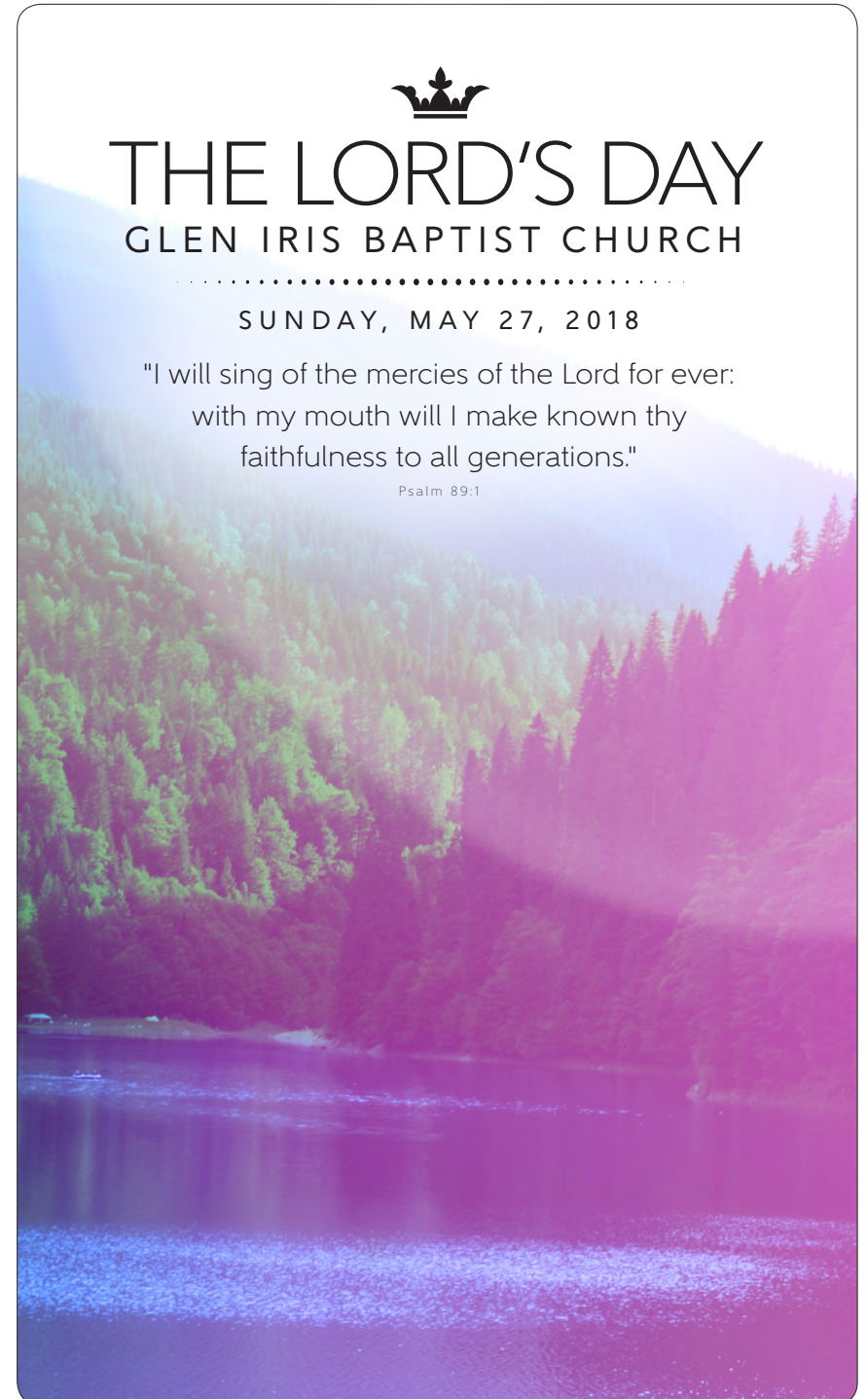
